
Launched in 2020 by CRI and UNESCO, The #LearningPlanet Festival gathers a growing and diverse community of passionate learners of all ages and countries: teachers and educators, youth and their families, artists and scientists, social entrepreneurs and policy makers, edtech innovators, etc.

Organised around the celebration of the International Day of Education, the Festival builds on the need to learn to take care of oneself, others and the planet through fostering a culture of hope, collective engagement and sustainability.

While in January 2021, the Festival was held fully online, with 250 sessions – mainly talks, roundtables and workshops – taking place throughout the week and +/- 10,000 participants across the world, the 2022 edition will feature both **on-site events**, notably in schools and universities, and a broader range of **online activities** including hackathons, games, wellbeing activities, documentaries and artistic performances.

Co-creation is at the core of this global event. Hundreds of partner organisations - schools, universities, NGOs, cities, youth organisations, etc. – are joining forces under a shared banner to offer a rich and diverse programme, inviting participants to share ideas and experiences, explore inspiring solutions and come together around shared challenges.


HOW TO GET INVOLVED

UN Celebration of the International Day of Education

UNESCO will celebrate the International Day of Education live in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, in partnership with the World Expo organisers. A unique opportunity to explore the futures of education, recognise exemplary on-the-ground educators and to listen to the voice of youth participants.

Youth-led activities!

Kids4SDGs, Asia's leading not-for-profit community of Sustainable Development Goals advocates and changemakers, will host a global youth-designed online STEMxSDG hackathon over the course of one week, from 22 to 29 January.

The Dais (India) along with partners globally will be facilitating 20 events locally led by educational institutions, on futures of education; events designed for school and university students as well as teachers and administrators, will be including a range of activities such as consultations, debates, workshops, music & arts, yoga, etc.


At the school level
