# THE DAIS GLOBAL VOICES MODEL UNITED NATIONS AT LEARNINGPLANET FESTIVAL THEME: FROM CITIZENSHIP TO PLANETIZENSHIP JANUARY 27TH - 28TH, 2023

The Dais Global Voices Model United Nations 2023 envisions a global community of youth working collectively as well as locally, (virtually and in situ) to co-create solutions towards the problems that the world is facing today as well as the future. The Model UN is being hosted by The Dais & Learning Planet Institute with several key partners with the theme, 'From Citizenship to Planetizenship'.

The Model UN Conference is being hosted by the Partners as part of the LearningPlanet Festival 2023 with it's theme, 'Learning to take care of oneself, others and the planet'.

Participation is free for all youth between 14 - 25 years and the sessions will be held on zoom.

The aim of the Model UN is also to build knowledge and awareness, providing tools to the youth to be able to organise Model UN under their leadership and to participate in them and will also see workshops hosted for both effective participation and organising.

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

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## LearningPlanet Festival

LearningPlanet Festival is a global celebration of learning, hosted around the International Day of Education.

In 2022, between 22nd and 30th January, the programme welcomed:

- 450+ online sessions on key themes: Youth Empowerment, Learning for Sustainability, New Models for Social Change, Transitions in Education, and Arts for Education
- 250+ Partner organisations
- 400+ high-level speakers
- 25,000 participants from 160+ countries active on the platform and several thousand on site participants in other key events of partners like UNESCO, Global Minnesota, SHEF, etc.

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## BENEFITS FOR YOUTH

**Become acquainted with global issues: MUNs expand one's knowledge about global issues as it obligates every delegate to understand them and their opinion may contribute to solving the problems that affect our planet today.**

**Nurture Public Speaking: MUN provides a great setting where people can try to face their fear of public speaking. This chance to overcome a fear of public speaking is great because it supports delegates' personal growth and triggers self-confidence.**

**Develop Diplomacy and Negotiation skills: Model UN conferences are diplomatic simulations. Respect and cooperation are the fundamentals of the debate. MUN teaches you how to be a good diplomat and will increase your diplomacy and negotiation skill which could be achieved through the process of lobbying other participants to agree with your interests.**

**Enhance leadership skill: Participants develop confidence and leadership skills through experience. As a representative of a country, one will make a decision as a leader. Model UN conferences are opportunities to practise research, public speaking, teamwork, negotiation, and writing skills in a safe and structured environment.**

**Exposure to perspectives and cultures: A Model UN conference is a concentration of delegates with different perspectives and from different cultures in the same place for a few days. This contact with different perspectives and settings is very useful to help you grow at a personal level and expand your horizons.**
